- I. The Outward Man
 - a. Refers to the physical being. This is important, even essential, but only in relation to the inward man.

- II. The Inward Man
 - a. The spiritual man
 - b. The spiritual man is renewed “day by day.” This calls for constant attention.
 - c. The renewal is a gradual process, not by one experience, but by a daily development.

- III. The Spiritual Application – “We Faint Not”
 - a. To look at the outward alone is to be discouraged.
 - b. Looking at the inward, there is hope.
 - c. “We faint not” because of the compensation as we shut out the view of the world.
