- I. Life as a vain show
 - a. Life is an image or symbol here. Surely every man walketh in a vain show or image or symbol.
 - b. Life is a shadow. Walketh in a vain show or shadow.
 - c. Life is a vapor. Comes swiftly and goes quickly.

- II. Life as a stranger
 - a. "I am a stranger." We must think of ourselves as strangers, not citizens.
 - b. "I am a sojourner."
 - c. "All my fathers were." The historical connection.

- III. The combination of life – "I am a stranger with thee."
 - a. I live casually in thy presence.
 - b. Thou art my companion.
 - c. I am in the care of the ruler of the world.
 - d. I am on a mission for him.
