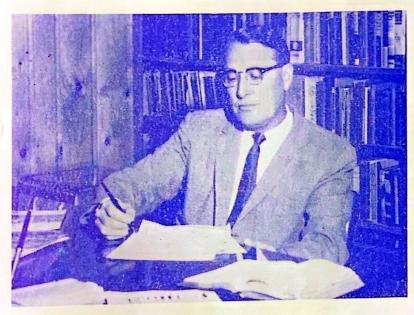

- District Rallies Conducted around one theme with a Purpose to Emphasize some phase of the W. A. Purpose.

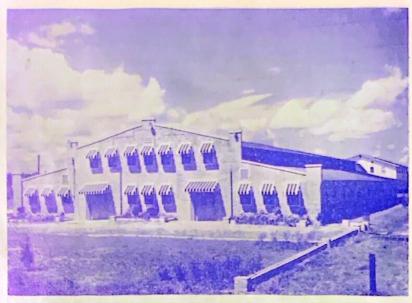

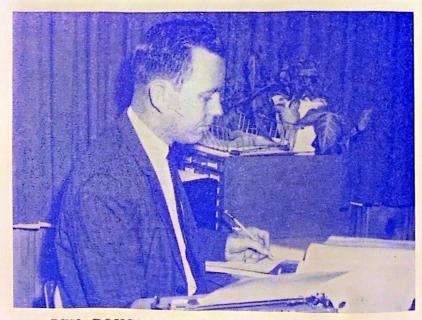
