I too was borned in poverty. I grew up as the step son of a farmer, wore pathhed clothes, when I was called to preach, I didnt have a coat to wear, af friend gave me the coat. I preached first in a old blue work shirt and mis matched coat and pants. at first.

But I came here as a boy but these years I have grown up.

I was little known. I wanted to make a mark in life like all ambitious men. I have never aspired to a big position.

But I wanted to preach to thousands of people. God has given me all I hoped for and a hundred times more.

I have been exalted by the people of my church across this nation to the highest honor next to the office of Bishop.

Member of General board of Administration. General se. and tres. of the Sunday School Board. Secretary of the Board of all Publications of the entecostal Holiness church. Member of the Eastern Board of Education.

I have preached in and have had the privilege of preaching in all of the largest Camp "eetings in this "ation and Canada and had a call to go to hold campaign in Africa.

On last Sunday night I preached to over three thousa people.

Not only have I realized my dream to preach to great crowds of people from the pulpit I have preached to multiplied thousands over the ream.

On my own program and over the "ational Hook up.

Now in that field my dreams have come true. I now only want to serve my generation and do the most good where God wants me to serve.
