As a church we try to do all the good we can to the town and community we are in. We have organized workers visiting Hospitals, Jails We have organized a soul winners club,

Whe church sponsors a large growing Boy Scout troop and in every way possible the church serves the community.

The future is bright at Rockingham, the sky is the limit.

Those of you who think the pastor of East Rockingha is riding a gravy train, ought to go with him just one seven days and nights.
