Most of you know that we have a Carp "esting Tabernacle at Rockinsham and also a Camp "esting. This Carp Meeting has been go ing on for about 28 years. But for the past few years it was nothing more than a local revival. The ministers of the Rockingham District saw the opportunity here so we got together and organized it into a District Camp Meeting. And for the past two years it has really taken new life, Especially that year. This year we had a fine group of workers, in fact almost the same ones we have here. Bro. Spence, Bro Edwards, Bro. Moore, Miss Tiny and Vera Manley. We had a daily broadcast right from the Camp Ground, that added much to the Camp "eeting. Bro. Moore also conducted his Annual Training Institute in conjunction with the Gamp. **xixxisyatharxitxwasx** The Camp Meeting was well attended and many souls were blessed. All together it was one of the greatest occasions of that kind that Rockingham had ever had.

Finally about the actual progress of the church:

We have had two good revivals, immediately after last Conference, Bro. Gurganus had a wonderful revival, and in the Spring Bro. Thurmon had another good revival.
