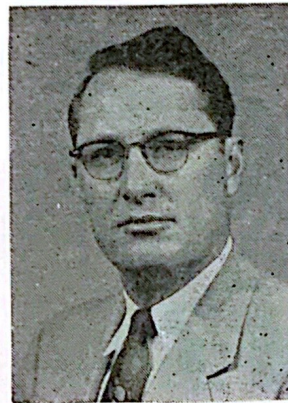

How To Make Your World Missions Emphasis A Success

FOR a number of years the South Carolina Conference has designated one month of each year as Mission Month. For this month every church is urged and expected to raise at least one dollar per member for Missions.

In addition to this every pastor, every evangelist and every mission worker is asked to give a personal donation. All auxiliaries and departments of the church are urged to put forth every effort during this one month to reach the goal of one dollar per member.

This offering is received at the last service of the Camp Meeting on Sunday afternoon. It is called the Annual Mission March. It is received by churches and by districts and by individuals. The church, the district and the individual raising or giving the most money in that month is announced and special recognition given to the winners.

Last year one church raised \$22.20 per member. It was declared the winner.

This plan has worked wonderfully. It does not interrupt the regular monthly financial program and for several years we have received over \$5,000 in each annual conference for missions.

The idea of competition and recognition together with a basic sense of loyalty to the church and the cause of missions is responsible for this fine success every year.
