- I. By Whom Are Men Blinded. "The god of this world."
 - a. The extent of his territory. "This world." A wide domain. Wherever man is, Satan goes. He receives homage of the world.
 - b. The extent of his power. "Prince of the power of the air." He projects himself into the most sacred places, some of God come together. The buler of darkness.
 - c. The time of his reign. "God of this age."
- II. To What Are Men Blinded. "The light of the glorious gospel of Christ."
 - a. The gospel light is a revealing light. It penetrates the unreal; shows the nature of sins; shows the remedy of sin.
 - b. The gospel is a guiding light, by it we can find the right way in life. The gospel is a lamp under our feet, etc.
 - c. The gospel is a glorious light. It reveals the glory of God, of Christ, and of all the privileges of the Christian here and hereafter.
- III. How Men Are Blinded. "Hath blinded the minds of them which believe not."
 - a. By substituting wealth, fame, sinful pleasures, etc.
 - b. By diversion.
 - c. By failing to read the Word and pray.
