  - a. Jesus hold this possible.
  - b. Impossible this would put the work of salvation upon human races.
- II. Not By Natural Selection. Nor "Will Of The Flesh."
  - a. If by natural selection the strong would have a little chance.
  - b. Favorable conditions would play a too large a part. c. If by flesh the divine element would be eliminated.
- III. Not By Human Ingenuity, Nor Of The Will Of Man.
  - a. Not by anything that man can do.
  - b. Not by invention of man.
  - c. If so, the divine element would be eliminated.
  - IV. The New Birth A Divine Work. "But Of God."
    - a. Heredity may effect our lives, but cannot make us sons of God.
    - b. Natural environment may have a powerful influence, but it cannot change our nature.
    - c. Man has many inventions, but none to fix the destiny of the soul for good. He controls, air, heart, sound, etc., but not the soul.
    - d. It is a divine work.
