I. A Discovered Need. "They Have No Wine."

- a. Even as Christ may have "Some lacking--may be a need of more complete adjustment. This was true of Martha. May a need due to a neglect, etc.
- b. Backsliders have need. There is an aching void. Peter had this. One look of Christ broke his heart. He got too close to Christ's enemies.
- c. Sinners who have not known Christ have a need. Tell of my experience as a boy when it was cold in early summer and I was afraid, and about the gun and dogs.

II. What To Do With Our Needs.

- a. We cannot work them out for ourselves.
- b. Bring them to Christ.
- c. Must do what he says.

III. Christ Meeting Our Needs.

- a. He is always on hand, at the critical hour of the wedding feast, He was there. When the thief was facing His last opportunity, he was there. He met Paul on the road to Damascus.
- b. He anticipates our needs. When the disciples had fished all night without success He said cast your net on the right side. He prepared fish for them. He said Martha thou troubled about many things. He cleansed the leper. Restored the man from the tomb.
