I. It Was A Message Designed For All People.

- a. To the Greek it was clothed in language of joy. "All hail" or rejoice ye.
- b. To Jews and Eastern people, it was clothed in the language of "peace be unto you."
- c. Christ speaks in the language of each individual.

II. It Is A Message Designed To All Conditions.

- a. It was a message of joy for the sorrowful. "All hail" or rejoice.
- b. It was a message of peace for the distressed disciples. "Peace be unto thee."
- c. It was a message of understanding for the perplexed followers on their way to Emmaus.

III. It Was A Good Morning Designed For All Duration.

- a. To Mary and the other women it was the morning of eternal joy.
- b. To the distressed disciples it was the morning of eternal peace.
- c. To Thomas it was the morning of eternal confidence.
- d. To the perplexed disciples it was the morning of eternal hope.

IV. For All It Should Be A Morning Of Activity.

- a. We must not be satisfied with enjoying the benefits of the resurrection.
- b. We must share it with us. "Go tell my bretheren."
- c. The resurrection good morning should be reflected in a new spirit of fellowship which transforms every day and every relationship.
