THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRET IS LOVE. GAL. 5.22

Here is a contrast of the works of the flesh and the fruit of the Spitit.

Here is a pretty gruesome picture of conflict that ends in complete triumph for one and complete vanquishment of the other.

There can be no tuuce or harmony between the two. There can be no armistice. No reconciliation.

Each is bent on the banishment of the other.

Paul is describing the trouble and conflicts that arises in carnal mind life. Here he sarnestly ezorts them to : Walk in the spirit.

He shows the subsequent and inevitable results of trying to live with the car nal mind, or trying to bear fruit and obey the lusts of the flesh at once.

Christianity is an individual affair.

Theology and doctrine may be questioned and doubted.

But Chtistianity wins its final victory in the individual life. I a life that is loved mastered.

He shows the gruesome pile of the works of the flesh and ina word says the Fruit of the Spitit is LOVE.

He seems to pause here this is a complete sentence.

Some translators have tried to change the verb here to say the fruies of the spirit are Love, joy, etc

But I take it that it is ajust as Paul meant it. THR FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT IS:LOVE.
He has said it all here.

We often hear of these graces called the nine fruits of the !

But in one semce there is only one fruit of the Spibit.

All of these others are but the qualities, quamities and flavors of theis fruit broken up into its component parts.

They are simply the diversifying flavors of the one fruit of the spirit.

Leve is the ocrastra and these are the notes of harmony that flow along the great music of love.

The three words here of special significance are

FRUIT SPIRIT, LOVE

1- Fruit presupposes life.

There can be no fruit without life.

It also presupposes growth.
A fruit bearing chaistian vibrates with life and development.

Jesus said every branch in me that beareth fruit he purgeth it that it might bring fourth more fruit.

Every branch that beareth not fruit he taketh away.

Thus the constant process of development and growth is necessary to remain in the vine and draw life and sustenance from the vine.

2- Fuit indicates Cultivation;

Fuit comes to perfection only in the answer to the touch of cultivation.

(Fruit may grow uncuntivated, but it will be faukty, culls and will fully mature)

3- Fruit naturally suggests sustenance,, food.

The fruit of the christian life is food for a starving world. This world has eat the husks of the swine long enough. They have been fed of theology, ritual, formalism, fanaticism, emptiness, husks if you please, long enough What this world meeds most is the display of real christian fruit.

4- Fruit here contains within it the power of proposation.
The power to reproduce after itd kind.

The fruitm of the Spitirmane God given, God inspired, But the works of the flesh are the works of men.

They contain within them the elements of death.

They are all within the realm of death and contain within them the elements of disintegration.

Mans finest works are in the realm of death.

These Buildings, could not be erected until man handled dead aterials.

The tree must die before man can carve it into his works.

Even while man works to effect his finest product the old moss fingers of mackboxxx time beging his work of tearing it down.

Man may paint a picture of fruit but it will fade.

Man may make it of wax but it will perish.

5- Fruit implies caltivation:

Not all cultivation is cleasant. It takes digging pruning cutting back. Cutting off old hardened roots.
